

# Fiduciary award winner

**Marieta Uys of PSG Trust** in Pretoria received the **Top FPSA® Candidate Award 2016** at the 7th Annual Fiduciary Institute of South Africa (FISA) conference in Sandton earlier this year.

FPSA stands for **Fiduciary Practitioner of South Africa®** and is a professional designation offered to members of FISA on application when they comply with education, examination, experience and ethics requirements.

As from 2018, anyone who wishes to apply to FISA for the FPSA designation will need to successfully complete the **Advanced Diploma in Estate and Trust Administration** offered by

the **School for Financial Planning Law (SFPL)** at the University of the Free State.

The award, sponsored by the SFPL, is made annually to the candidate who achieved the highest marks for the three required modules during the previous year's FPSA examinations.

Uys scored an average of **78.7%** for **Law and Ethics in Fiduciary Services, Wills Consultation and Drafting, and Estate Administration**. The award consists of a trophy and certificate, a **R10 000** cash prize, and registration free of charge to attend the FISA conference at which the award is handed over.
