FISA uses the event management system called Cvent for registrations to regional meetings and the FISA Conference, enabling functions like system generated CPD certificates, etc.

Some of our members do not receive the invitations to meetings because their company IT firewalls block the emails. To address this problem the IP addresses and domains on this list can be “whitelisted”.

What Cvent IP addresses should we whitelist?

If your tech department only allows traffic from approved sites on their servers or wants to connect an application to Cvent, they'll need to whitelist the following IP addresses:

- 198.207.147.224/27 – for Cvent emails
- 204.239.0.224/27 – for Cvent emails

When emails are delivered, they come from a Cvent domain behind the scenes. When updating your whitelist, you'll also want to include the following domains:

- cventmail.com
