Brenton Ellis advised that he has received 200 fast-track files and same is available for collection from his office. Preference will be given to FISA members. He further advised that Government Printing Works is not currently posting advertisements.

Question from Lauren Heen:

Kindly advise whether FISA has a line of communication with Government Printing Works regarding the issues of printing. Is it able to place adverts via the manual process as indicated on the FISA newsletter?

Brenton Ellis advised that the Government Gazatte released a circulate that stated that their problems have not been resolved and that they are not able to publish legal gazettes at this time.

Question from Lauren Heen:

Kindly advise when Business Day will be able to publish adverts.

Answer:

Louis van Vuuren indicated that he does not know.

Marius Potgieter stated that advert cannot be placed with Business Day at present.

Louis van Vuuren advised that, of the complaints lodged by FISA over the past 3 years, $2/3^{rd}$ have been with regards to deceased estates. 70% were Pretoria, Johannesburg and Cape Town Masters of the High Court. He added that FISA are sending complaints on a weekly basis, with 61 complaints in the previous week. It is noted that the Master of the High Court is willing to engage with FISA.

5. SARS

Mr. Williams (SARS) and Ms Gain (SARS) are present and welcomed by Ryno Venter. Nicolaas Brink has not reported any issues with SARS.
